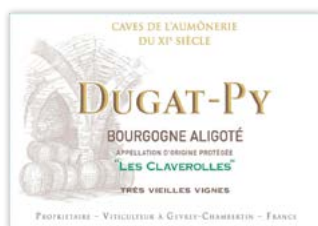


DOMAINE DUGAT-PY / Burgundy

Presentation

The Dugat family have been vine-growers in the Gevrey-Chambertin appellation of Burgundy since the early 17th century, making this one of the region's longest-established viticultural lineages. Today, Bernard Dugat-Py and his son Loïc Dugat-Py represent the 12th and 13th generations of the family at the domaine, perpetuating an expertise in vine-growing and winemaking that has evolved over more than four centuries.

Located in the historic heart of the old village of Gevrey-Chambertin, at the foot of the Combe de Lavaux, the estate occupies ancient vaulted cellars known as the Aumônerie. These remarkable underground spaces date from the 11th and 12th centuries and are all that remain of an early medieval abbey that once belonged to the Abbey of Saint-Bénigne in Dijon. According to the domaine's records, the cellars were constructed under the direction of Aumônier (Abbot) Halinard, and are regarded as some of the oldest wine-aging cellars in Burgundy. Continuing a tradition that stretches back nearly a millennium, Dugat-Py wines are matured in these magnificent stone-vaulted cellars, where stable natural conditions provide an ideal environment for long-term aging.

Soils

Dugat-Py's vineyards grow on clay-limestone soils, providing structure, balance, and minerality that shape the precision and elegance of its Pinot Noir wines.

Viticulture & Winemaking

Certified Organic and Biodynamic, work in the vineyard is extremely natural, with biodynamic preparations, horse plowing in the 1er and Grand Cru vineyards, and no vine trimming.

The vineyard is cultivated like a meticulous garden, reflecting a rare know-how and an unwavering attention to the smallest details. Many plots are planted with old vines from massal selection, yielding grapes of exceptional concentration and giving the wines a singular density and depth.

Winemaking at Dugat-Py follows a traditional, low-intervention philosophy. Fermentations use a large proportion of whole clusters and indigenous yeasts, allowing each wine to express its terroir naturally. Wines are aged in carefully selected French oak barrels for 12 to 20 months, depending on the cuvée, in the domaine's historic vaulted cellars, where stable temperature and humidity encourage slow, graceful maturation.

The wines are vinified without artifice and bottled without fining or filtration, producing vibrant, complex wines with a clear imprint of the Gevrey-Chambertin terroir. They reveal their full character only after several years of careful aging, rewarding patience with nuance, power, and elegance.

The estate has been certified organic since 2015, underscoring a commitment to sustainability and the preservation of soil health for generations to come.
